The Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) is a survey conducted in a sample of West Virginia middle and high schools during the spring of odd numbered years. With funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the WV Department of Education, Office of Research, Accountability, and Data Governance, administers the YRBS with the assistance of the RESA Regional Wellness Network. This presentation will review the results of the 2015 YRBS for both high school and middle school students. Topics include tobacco use, violence, injury, bullying, suicidal thoughts and behaviors, alcohol use, drug use, sexual behavior, weight management and dieting, chronic disease and disease prevention, nutritional intake, and physical activity. Time trend analysis as well as gender and grade level differences in behavior will be presented. Available dissemination products such as fact sheets for each topic will also be available for participants.
