This webinar will discuss the neonatal effects of drug dependency during pregnancy. It will provide school nurses and school-based health center staff with knowledge and resources to assist pregnant and parenting teens and adults with drug diversion techniques. The webinar will also provide education on Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS). Current nursing licensure renewal requires 1 CE in drug diversion every year.
